



HELP MAKE EFFINGHAM HAPPIER!

Help us make our community happier and healthier by making the most of Effingham's public green spaces!

As a gift to the Effingham community the members of St. Lawrence's Effingham with All Saints Little Bookham Parish are clearing and revitalising a small area of land on The Street in central Effingham (the patch opposite the Methodist Church) to create a new Community Orchard. The Orchard will be flanked by fruit trees and a wildflower bank and be populated by year-round shrubs. A seating area will form a space for rest and conversation as people go about their business up and down The Street.



Surrey County Council Highways have approved our roadside plans which complement and support further climate change initiatives from Effingham Parish Council.

Members of St. Lawrence's Effingham with All Saints Little Bookham Parish have already started clearing the ground and are funding the professional clearance of weeds. This spring we will plant the new trees and bushes.

This project will cost up to £4000 in addition to the contribution from the churches. You are warmly invited to contribute – as much or as little as you like – to help re-create this into a calm, beautiful, friendly space at the centre of our village. Your contribution can help buy the following:

Fruit trees | Large and small shrubs | Wildflower seed | Turf | Woody mulch
Wall fixtures | Benches from Norbury Park Sawmill (Wildlife Trust).
