## 1.10 Proposed changes to the Constitution

The committee propose the following modifications to the Constitution:

### **New Section 8.**

#### "Section 8 HONORARY PRESIDENT

- a) The Association may from time to time appoint one or more Honorary Presidents. An Honorary President shall be a Member who has contributed substantially to the life of the village and the Association over a long period of time and whom the Association wishes to honour in this way.
- b) An Honorary President shall be elected by the Association at the Annual General Meeting. Nominations for election as Honorary President shall be sent in writing together with the name of the proposer and seconder to the Secretary to reach him or her at least 10 days before the Annual General Meeting at which the election is to take place.
- c) The appointment will be for an agreed fixed term and can be renewed. The appointment can be terminated by the holder or Executive Committee during that time.
- d) Honorary President is a ceremonial role and does not carry any duties. An Honorary President is not a member of the Executive Committee unless elected separately to that role."

Renumber existing sections 8 to 14 and make minor changes as detailed below

Section 9. General Meetings replace "Reports of the Executive Committee," by "a"

Section 14 replace "Rules" in heading and text by "Constitution."

Section 15 c) replace "Minutes" in heading and text by "Constitution."
