



# Effingham and Little Bookham



**Saturday 9th September 2023**

***An opportunity to visit these historic buildings***

## 1. Effingham Golf Club

**Open 9am to 12 noon only**

One of top 100 golf courses has Grade II listed Georgian clubhouse with later additions. Formerly Effingham Manor House from 1823. The famous golf club designer, Harry Shapland Colt designed the course in 1927.

## 2. Methodist Chapel \*

**Open 10am to 4pm (Also Friday 10am to 4pm & Sunday 12noon to 4pm)**

Wesleyan Chapel built in 1854. Church & village history displays. Children's activities featuring dinosaurs, fossils and meteorites. Local RSPB birdwatching guide.

## 3. St Lawrence Church

**Open Saturday 10am to 4pm. Also accessible other times.**

Grade II\* listed church dating from 12th century with history displays and grave of Sir Barnes Wallis in the churchyard.

## 4. Our Lady of Sorrows Catholic Church

**Open 11am to 4pm**

Pretty church, consecrated in 1913 and funded by local resident and railway engineer, George Pauling.

## 5. All Saints Church

**Open 10am to 4pm**

Pretty Grade II\* listed church originating from around 1100 in lovely setting with one of the finest sets of funeral hatchments in Surrey. Displays on church history and essential renovation works just completed.

## 6. Manor House School

**Open 10am to 5pm**

Elegant Grade II listed 18th century former manor house extended in 19th and 20th centuries and set in beautiful gardens. Home of school since 1937. Displays and self-guided tours.

## 7. Manor Farm Tith Barn\*

**Special Event**

**Sir Barnes Wallis**

**Open 9am to 5pm**

Remembering the Dambuster and Operation Chastise 80 years on. Displays & showings of BBC Barnes Wallis documentaries (by license) Tea and cakes in the Barn and courtyard garden

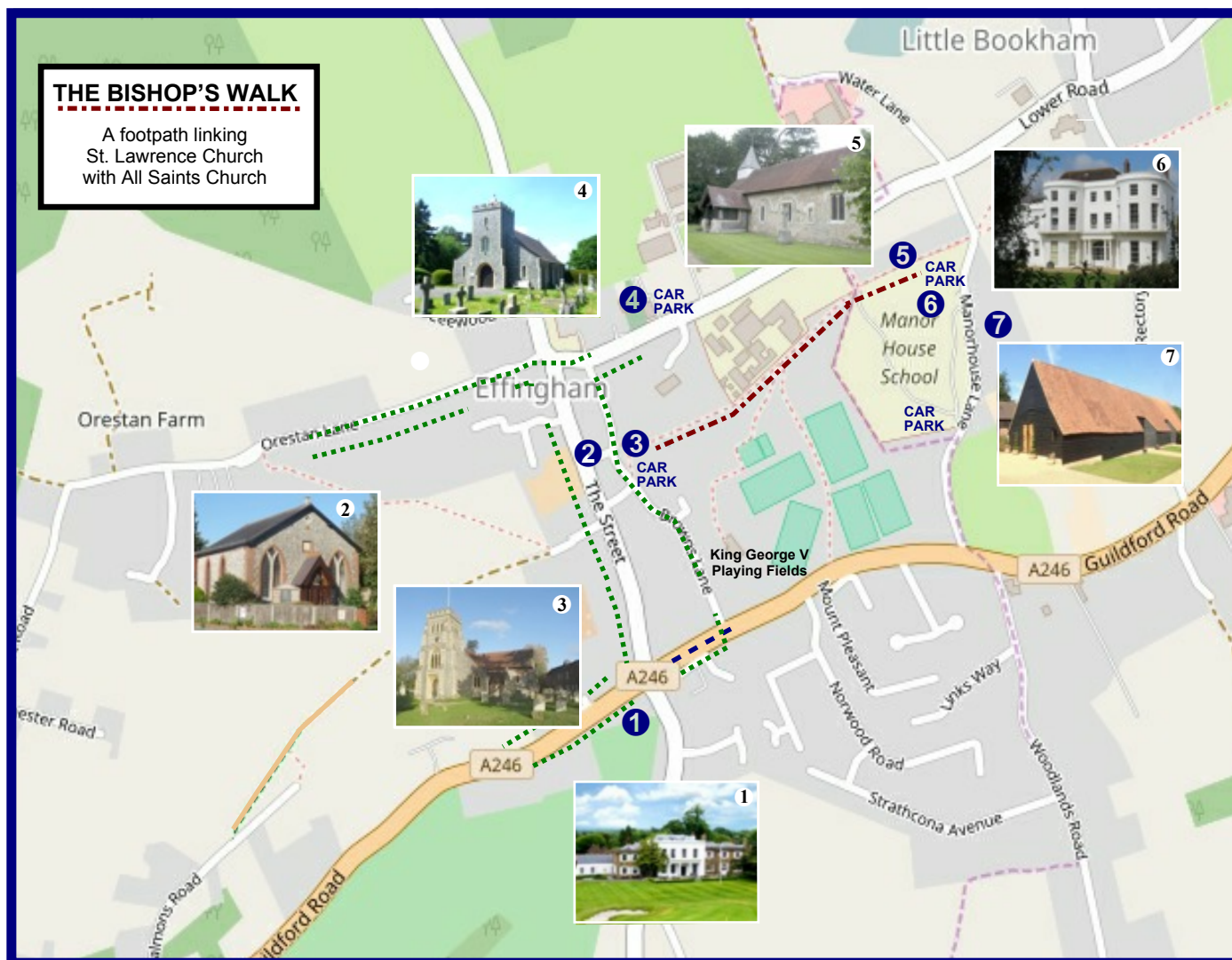
